- 3. The above item 2 notwithstanding, you agree that should you be found liable in a court of law for any reason related to your Geetel Communications services, our liability is limited to the unused portion of your subscription fee.
- 4. This system contains an unabridged copy of the information known as "UseNet" and portions of the system may contain messages which you may find offensive. Geetel Communications does not censor or in any way control the contents of this or any other on-line information. Nearly all of the information found here originates on systems other than those under direct Geetel Communications control. Geetel Communications cannot confirm the proper classification of information presented in any areas of the system.
